

## ORDINANCE NO. 1986 - 001

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE STATE LAW ON SNOWMOBILE  
AND ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES, ALSO TO INCLUDE DIRT BIKES  
OR TRAIL BIKES, AND TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF THE  
SAME UPON CITY STREETS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City of Parker, Armstrong County,  
Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the  
same as follows:

ARTICLE I

Act 1985 - 56 of the laws of Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and  
as "The Snowmobile and All Terrain Vehicle Law" is, in its entirety a  
part of this ordinance.

ARTICLE II

SECTION A - DEFINITIONS: - The definition of such words as  
"snowmobile", "all terrain vehicle", "cowling", "head and  
tail lamps", "low pressure tires", "Department", and "street"  
as used in this ordinance is given in SECTION 7701, Page 1 of  
the attached "Snowmobile And ATV Law."

SECTION B - REGISTRATIONS: - All snowmobiles and ATVs operating  
on city roads must be registered by the Department of Environmental  
Resources, and display the proper identifying decals and numbers  
as specified in SECTION 7712 and SECTION 7713, pages 2 and 3 of  
the "snowmobile and ATV Law.

Also, this ordinance shall be construed to apply to unlicensed  
trail bikes or dirt bikes.

Additionally, all such vehicles regulated under this ordinance  
shall be issued a number by the City of Parker which at all  
times shall be prominently displayed upon the vehicle and upon  
the helmet of the operator.

Lastly, each owner of such vehicle shall furnish proof of being covered with liability insurance with limits of no less than \$15,000.00.

SECTION C - EXEMPTIONS FROM REGISTRATIONS: - Exemptions from registration shall be as specified in SECTION 7714 page 4 of the "snowmobile and ATV Law".

SECTION D - RECIPROCITY: - Reciprocity shall be as specified in SECTION 7715 page 4 of the "Snowmobile and ATV Law".

SECTION E - DESIGNATION OF SNOWMOBILE AND ATV ROADS" - The city will designate roads within its jurisdiction for snowmobile and ATV use in accordance with SECTION 7722 part (A) and (B) page 5 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

All such designated streets shall be used only as an exit or entrance upon leaving or entering the City of Parker and not as a general play area.

This ordinance shall not be construed to allow such vehicles to trespass upon private property or to travel upon any sidewalk.

SECTION F - LIABILITY: - As stated in SECTION 7722 part (C), of the "snowmobile ad ATV Law", there will be no liability imposed on the city as the result of designating any road within its jurisdiction as a snowmobile or ATV road.

SECTION G - OPERATION BY PERSONS UNDER AGE 16:- Any persons under the age of 16 operating a snowmobile or ATV on city roads must have completed the safety training course and be in compliance with the regulations as set forth in SECTION 7725 pages 6 and 7 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION H - OPERATE IN A SAFE MANNER:- Any snowmobile or ATV operating on city roads must be operated in a manner and at a speed that is in compliance with all the provisions of SECTION 7726 page 7 of the "snowmobile and ATV Law".

Additionally, operation shall be only between the hours of daylight and 9:00 o'clock P.M., November through March and daylight and 10:00 o'clock P.M., April through October.

SECTION I - LIMITATIONS ON OPERATORS: - The transportation of firearms or bows and arrows by a snowmobile or an ATV on city roads must be in compliance with SECTION 7729 page 8 of the "Snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION J - ACCIDENTS AND ACCIDENT REPORTS: - Any accident occurring on city roads ust be reported in the manner prescribed in SECTION 7728 page 9 of the "Snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION K - LIABILITY OF OWNER FOR NEGLIGENCE: - The owner of a snowmobile or ATV operated on city roads shall be liable for death or injury to persons or damage to property resulting from negligence in the operation of the machine as given in SECTION 7729 page 9 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION L - HEAD AND TAIL LAMPS: - The type and use of head and tail lamps used on snowmobiles and ATVs operating on city roads must be in accordance with SECTION 7741 page 10 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION M - HEAD AND TAIL LAMP OPERATIONS: - Head and tail lamps as specified is Section L of the this ordinance must be turned on at all times that a snowmobile or ATV is in operation on city roads approved for snowmobile and ATV use.

SECTION N - BRAKES: - Any snowmobile or ATV operating on city roads must be equipped with brakes that meets the standards prescribed in SECTION 7742 page 10 of the "snowmobile and ATV Law".

SECTION O - MUFFLERS AND NOISE CONTROL: - Any snowmobile or ATV operating on city roads must be equipped with a muffler that meets the standards prescribed in SECTION 7743 page 10 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION P - ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL: - Every law enforcement officer in the Commonwealth is authorized to enforce this ordinance as set forth in SECTION 7751 page 11 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION Q - PENALTIES: - Any person violating this ordinance will be subject to a fine as prescribed in SECTION 7752 page 11 of the "snowmobile And ATV Law".

SECTION R - REVOCATION: - The city Board of Supervisors reserves the right to recall, revise, or cancel all or any part of this ordinance.

DESIGNATED ROADS: - The following roads in the city are designated as snowmobile and ATV roads:

ARTICLE III

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
