ORDINANCE RESOLUTION NO. 2007-01

WHEREAS, the City of Parker has determined pursuant to its authority to provide for the health, welfare and education of the citizenry that building address numbers are desirable.

WHEREAS, these are desirable for the health and safety of the citizenry as it assists police, fire and emergency officials in finding houses and business' they are called to.

WHEREAS, it is found that not every home or business in the city properly displays a address number it is thereby resolved the following

1. Each and every owner of a home in the City limits of Parker, shall be required to prominently display house numbers no less than three (3) inches in height in a well lit area easily seen from the street.

2. COMPLIANCE

Compliance with the above shall be determined by the City Building Inspector or such other authority as is appointed from time to time.

3. PENALTY

A violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a \$ 25.00 fine. The Magisterial District Judge for the City shall hold a hearing at the request of the homeowner regarding any alleged violation of the Ordinance. He or she is specifically empowered to determine whether a violation has occurred.

4. DATE OF EFFECT

This Ordinance shall take effect June 1, 2007.

5. SEVERABILITY

It is hereby resolved that should any section of this Ordinance be deemed illegal or unconstitutional each separate part of the Ordinance shall be severable therefrom. It is the specific finding of counsel that this Ordinance would have been adopted had the offending provision not been within it.
